

# Feasibility and reliability of a new measure of MS intention tremor

## **KEY FACTS – Brief summary of the research**

### **What is the purpose of the research?**

To evaluate a new measurement system designed to record upper limb intention tremor in individuals with Multiple Sclerosis (MS) during functional movements of the arm.

The tremor measurement study is run by a research physiotherapist and an engineer from the University of Bristol. You would be asked to attend the MS Research Unit for two visits.

### **Who is the programme suitable for?**

People who:

- are 18 years or older
- have a confirmed diagnosis of MS
- have visible tremor in their hand / arm when they reach forward to pick up an object

### **What would taking part in the research involve?**

- Attending the MS Research Unit
- Assessment of the arm
- Wearing the measurement system on the arm during a series of functional tasks
